Propose Speech Team--Mrs. Goff

This team will help students with communication skills, language skills, public speaking and prepare them to be college and /or career ready. Approval was given by consensus to begin this club.

Propose French Class --Mrs. Harwood

Mrs. Harwood proposed bringing French Class back to WCHS. It would give our students another option for a language credit. We have many students who would be interested in taking French as their language. There would be no cost to add this class as Mrs. Harwood has all the materials from the last time she taught French. Mr. Tolbert advised that he would take it into consideration with the new scheduling.

Propose Drama Class -- Mrs. McGinty

Mrs. McGinty has proposed a Drama/ Theater class for WCHS. This class would provide our students with better communication and language skills. It would also give the students access to an additional pathway choice, making these students college and /or career ready. The class would be focusing on our talented students who would like to pursue the arts as a career. Mr. Tolbert advised that he would take it into consideration with the new scheduling.

CTE performance based credits

Mrs. Thomison proposed that CTE courses become performance based credit courses. All CTE courses will equal one credit. This change is needed due to career pathway requirements. Approval was given by consensus.

CTE course and pathway changes for 15-16 school year

Mrs. Thomison proposed the addition of 2 majors in FCS : Culinary Arts and Fundamentals of Teaching. In addition, FCS will add 3 new courses: Culinary Arts, Culinary Arts II, Mid to Late Life Span Development. The last curriculum change is to make Business Principles and Applications a technology credit.

Approval was given by consensus.

Mr. Tolbert requested permission to draw from Section 7 monies for a Dean of students and for funds to help the baseball team this year. Permission was given by consensus of the council.

CLASSES RATHER THAN THE .75 THAT IS CURRENTLY GIVEN. MR. TOLBERT ADVISED THAT HE WOULD CHECK INTO THIS. ANOTHER ITEM THAT SHE DISCUSSED WAS THE FACULTY MEETING ON JANUARY 21ST. THERE IS A QUESTION AS TO WHETHER THE TEACHERS ARE REQUIRED TO GO SINCE PD CREDIT WILL BE GIVEN TO THE NEW TEACHERS FOR THIS MEETING. THE THINKING IS THAT IF A TEACHER HAS ALL HIS/HER PD CREDIT THEY WOULD NOT NEED TO ATTEND THE MEETING. MR. TOLBERT ASSURED THE COUNCIL THAT THIS IS A REQUIRED FACULTY MEETING AND ALL TEACHERS WERE EXPECTED TO ATTEND. OUR NEW TEACHERS, WHO DIDN'T GET A CHANCE TO GET ALL OF THEIR PD HOURS THIS SUMMER, WERE FORTUNATE TO HAVE THIS EXTRA OPPORTUNITY TO EARN THESE HOURS. MR. TOLBERT ALSO STATED THAT HE WOULD BE AVAILABLE TO DISCUSS THIS WITH ANY OF OUR TEACHERS IF THEY NEED FURTHER EXPLANATION.
